What is JustFaith?

Just Faith is an extended education process in social justice. It focuses on the social mission of the church and on the role of a Christian in our world today. Included in the program are justice issues of our daily life as well as global justice issues. You are invited to become part of a community to study and explore our faith journey and to become God's compassion and healing that is life-giving for all.

What is involved?

- Weekly 2½ hour meetings.
- Retreats in September and April.
- Visits and dialogue with people who have or are experiencing injustice.
- About two hours of reading each week.

Who is this for?

- People who want to learn more about the Church's social justice tradition.
- People who are looking for spiritual growth.

Why participate?

- To gain a better understanding of the Church's social mission from the Scriptures, the Church's historical witness, and Catholic social teaching.
- To integrate personal spirituality and social ministry.

Timing

- Although the program runs for 30 weeks topics are covered in 5-week blocks. At the end of each block you will be invited to participate in the next block
- The full program is similar to taking a college course (without written assignments) or a year long adult education class.
- The length of the full program is similar to what we ask of our RCIA participants.

The registration cost is \$20 per person.

You will have access to all the necessary books as part of the registration. If you are interested in owning a book you may purchase it individually.

Location and day will be determined according to the registration.
