I am a citizen and resident of Canada and I believe that section 2 of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms includes the freedom of conscience, freedom of thought and expression and freedom of religion as fundamental freedoms.

I believe that the Government of Canada must defend the rights of Canadians regardless of whether the current Government agrees with the specific views held by individual Canadians.

I believe that Canadian employers who believe in the legal protection of unborn children and in traditional marriage should be eligible to apply for federal funding programs.

I believe that the current Government's requirement that an attestation, that attests that the employer holds the same views as the Government, be signed to apply for funding under the Canada Summer's Job program contravenes the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. No Canadian should have to attest to a belief that is against their conscience and their religion in order to receive government protection and benefits.
