Jesus' life in the body becomes our life in the body - through the Eucharist.

We need to have reverence for our bodies.

We live in a culture that treats the body like an object owned by a person. Christianity radically professes that body and soul together are a person: we are our bodies. This was always true. Then Jesus showed us why it matters: God is working out our salvation through Jesus' life, death and bodily Resurrection, inviting us to follow Him. This means our salvation is connected to how we live in the body. So it matters spiritually how you live in and with your body, how you think about it, how you treat it, and that you reverence your body's participation in God's work. Think of one way you can improve your reverence for your body this week and practise. Go to bed on time. Eat food that nourishes you. Move. Speak about your body with respect and reverence. Serve someone else by mowing the lawn, carrying groceries, or giving a backrub. Soak aching muscles. Thank God for the gift of a body that is participating in your salvation.

Prayer: *Jesus, Body and Blood, you offered yourself so completely that you nourish us with yourself, that we might live and die and rise again as we follow you. Help us to treat our bodies with reverence and respect. Teach us to let your Body and Blood dwell in ours. Amen.*
