## OUR LADY OF FATIMA: 100th Anniversary!

In 1917, Our Lady appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal. They were Lucia Santos [10], Blessed Francisco Marto [9] and Blessed Jacinta Marto [7]. The first apparition was on Sunday, May 13, 1917. She appeared to them once a month from May through October. She then instructed the children to pray the Rosary daily to end the war and bring peace to the world. She also asked that the following prayer be recited at the end of each decade of the Rosary: *“O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those most in need of Thy mercy. Amen.”*

Our Lady entrusted the children with three secrets. The **first** was a vision of Hell. The **second** was a prophecy about the end of World War I and the beginning of World War II, and the need for the conversion of Russia. The **third** secret concerned the Holy Father suffering greatly and the persecution of the Church. On her final appearance [13 October 1917], Our Lady's promised miracle occurred. The sun appeared to dance in the sky; an event witnessed by thousands of people. The apparition was approved by the Holy See in 1930. 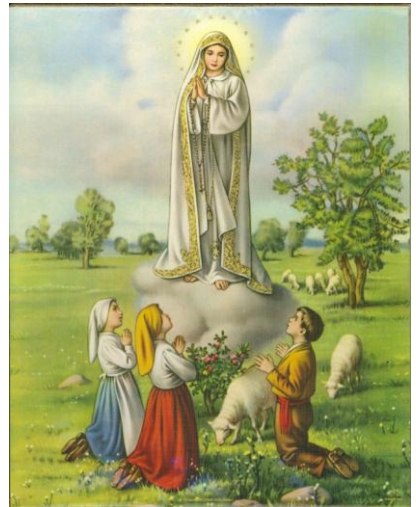
