October is the Month of the Rosary



October 1st, 26th Sunday of Ordinary Time:

“Son, go and work in the vineyard today.” And he answered, ‘I will not;’ but afterward he repented and went.

This parable is about the central Christian concern of how the human will, made rebellious by sin and turned in on itself, can gradually open up, turn outward, and finally converge with the lifegiving will of God. And the exact will of God for us, in the light of this parable, is that we join him in the work of cultivating his “vineyard”, that is, in toiling to produce fine fruit from our human hearts, our Church, our world, so that the bursting grapes of the vineyard of creation will eventually yield the abundant wine of universal happiness and joy.

Jesus set us his story with the strict symmetry of a double reversal. An insolent initial refusal in words becomes in time an obedient acquiescence in deed, and a very courteous and enthusiastic initial compliance in words becomes a refusal in deed. A man shall be judged by his final condition, we are told in all the world’s wisdom literature, and not by his assurances of goodwill and good intentions along the way. What great patience is required both from God and from ourselves to live at peace with our human unfinishedness as we grope our way forward in the labyrinth of attitudes and choices, darkness and illumination, toward the fullness of the persons we are called to be! How much easier it is either to eulogize or to condemn a person before he has reached his goal and be done with it!

Who can fathom the mystery of why so often, it would seem, we need to act out a series of self-affirming and rebellious refusals, leading to dead-ends, before the sun rises interiorly and we can at last behold the beauty of communion through joyful obedience and collaboration? Why can we often learn the sweetness of a generous Yes only by first tasting the bitterness and isolation of a stubborn No? By contrast, when will we learn that the compulsion always to respond with a Yes, before reflection, can often be a symptom, not of generosity, but of an unhealthy desire to please and be approved, an interior condition that divides a person against himself and cannot result in effective commitment?

We may conclude from this parable that what God is looking for in us is not our initial response, the particular disposition in which he first happens to find us on approaching us, whether apparently good or apparently bad. God is interested, rather, in what we will do with our freedom in the long run. He fully realizes that he must continually surround us with his love and patience if we are to have the space and nurture necessary to grow into sharers of his life. Only God has the patience to wait throughout a lifetime for all our instinctual Nos to become one eternal Yes to his love. We will thus, in the end, come to embody the spontaneous interior attitude of the Lord, as Paul describes it: “The Son of God, Jesus Christ, was never Yes-and-No; his nature is all Yes” (2 Cor 1:19), and as Jesus himself reveal it to us in his perpetual exclamation: “Yes, Father!” (Matthew 11:26)

Dear Parishioners of Ste. Rose, Laurier and McCreary,

1. Regarding Sharing God's Gifts Appeal 2017

This year the Archdiocese has restructured its finances. In this restructuring the targets for the Parish Appeal, which is commonly known as *Sharing God's Gifts*, have been reduced.

Our targets for SGG this year 2017 are as follows: Ste. Rose \$8,420 Laurier \$2,410 McCreary \$1,890 While our *Appeal (SGG)* targets have been reduced, our Parish *Assessments* (the Archdiocesan tax) have been increased to 16% of our Sunday Collections from the previous year. Thus we will be assessed as follows: Ste Rose \$13,220, Laurier \$3,780, McCreary \$2,970

It would be to our advantage to think of these Assessment amounts as belonging also to our *Sharing God's Gifts* targets. Given this, the following would be our targets: **Ste Rose \$21,640 Laurier \$6,190 McCreary \$4,860**

Please note that any funds we collect over our SGG targets will be returned to our parishes untaxed. Thus, for instance, if Ste Rose collected \$22 000, \$13 580 (= 22000 – 8420) would be returned to our parish (and could be used for paying the Assessment).

Please pray about giving of your wealth according to the Stewardship model: 90% your needs 5% your Parish 3% other charities 2% Sharing God's Gifts.

2. Regarding the Ste Rose Roof

The work on the roof is almost complete! We hope to be able to report on the project soon.

We'd like to thank all those who have contributed to the Roof Fund, and in particular The Rainy Day Club, which is contributing \$60 000 to this project. These gifts will considerably lighten the financial strain on our parish. Yet much money still needs to be raised! Please help if you can.
