## November 12th, 32nd Sunday of Ordinary Time:

### *Can't you lead a good life without believing in Christianity?*

The question sounds as if it were asked by a person who said to himself, 'I don't care whether Christianity is in fact true or not. I'm more interested in finding out whether the real universe is more like what the Christians say than what the Materialists say. All I'm interested in is leading a good life. I'm going to choose beliefs not because I think them true but because I find them helpful.' I find it hard to sympathize with this state of mind. One of the things that distinguishes man from the other animals is that he wants to know things, wants to find out what reality is like, simply for the sake of knowing. When that desire is completely quenched in anyone, I think he has become something less than human. Not that you have really lost that desire. More probably, foolish preachers, by always telling you how much Christianity will help you and how good it is for society, have led you to forget that Christianity is not a kind of therapy. Christianity claims to give an account of *facts* – to tell you what the real universe is like. Its account of the universe may be true, or it may not, and once the question is really before you, then your natural inquisitiveness must make you want to know the answer. If Christianity is untrue, then no honest man will want to believe it, however helpful it might be: if it is true, every honest man will want to believe it, even if it gives him no help at all.

The question before each of us is not, 'Can *someone* lead a good life without Christianity?' The question is, 'Can *I*?' We all know there have been good men who were not Christians; supposing Christianity to be true, these men were in a state of honest ignorance or honest error. If their intentions were as good as I suppose them to have been (for of course I can't read their secret hearts) I hope and believe that the skill and mercy of God will remedy the evils which their ignorance, left to itself, would naturally produce both for them and for those whom they influenced. But the man who asks, 'Can't I lead a good life without believing in Christianity?' is clearly not in the same position. If he hadn't heard of Christianity he would not be asking this question. If, having heard of it, and having seriously considered it, he had decided that it was untrue, then once more he would not be asking the question. The man who asks this question has heard of Christianity and is by no means certain that it may not be true. He is really asking, 'Need I bother about it? Mayn't I just evade the issue, just let sleeping dogs lie, and get on with being "good"?'

The man is shirking. He is like the man who deliberately 'forgets' to look at the notice board because, if he did, he might find his name down for some unpleasant duty. He is not in a state of honest error. He is in a state of dishonest error. Honest rejection of Christ, however mistaken, will be forgiven and healed – 'Whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him' (Luke 22:10). But to *evade* the Son of Man, to look the other way, to pretend you haven't noticed, to become suddenly absorbed in something on the other side of the street, to leave the receiver off the telephone because it might be He who was ringing up – this is a different matter. You may not be certain yet whether you ought to be a Christian; but you do know you ought to be a man, not an ostrich, hiding its head in the sands.

**Dear Parishioners of Ste. Rose, Laurier and McCreary,**

**1. Regarding Sharing God's Gifts Appeal 2017**

This year the Archdiocese has restructured its finances. In this restructuring the targets for the Parish Appeal, which is commonly known as *Sharing God's Gifts*, have been reduced.

Our targets for SGG this year 2017 are as follows: Ste. Rose \$8,420 Laurier \$2,410 McCreary \$1,890

While our *Appeal* (SGG) targets have been reduced, our Parish *Assessments* (the Archdiocesan tax) have been increased to 16% of our Sunday Collections from the previous year. Thus we will be assessed as follows: Ste Rose \$13,220, Laurier \$3,780, McCreary \$2,970

It would be to our advantage to think of these Assessment amounts as belonging also to our *Sharing God's Gifts* targets. Given this, the following would be our targets: **Ste Rose \$21,640 Laurier \$6,190 McCreary \$4,860**

Please note that any funds we collect over our SGG targets will be returned to our parishes untaxed. Thus, for instance, if Ste Rose collected \$22 000, \$13 580 (= 22000 – 8420) would be returned to our parish (and could be used for paying the Assessment).

Please pray about giving of your wealth according to the Stewardship model: 90% your needs 5% your Parish 3% other charities 2% Sharing God's Gifts.

**2. Regarding the Ste Rose Roof**

The work on the roof (but not the ceiling) is now complete, and we have received the invoice for the work, coming with taxes to a little more than 88 thousand dollars (precisely what was initially quoted).

Keep in mind that we still have quite a lot of work to do on the ceiling, which was damaged by water, and the electrical in the ceiling, much of which will have to be replaced. Thus we still have funds to raise -- please continue to support this work.

**3. Regarding the Synod**

The Archbishop's Synod is moving into its third phase: all parishes are sending delegates to a number of conventions in Winnipeg, where the delegates will vote on a number of propositions written by the various Synod committees. Please pray that the delegates would be blessed with wisdom and discretion.

These upcoming conventions in Winnipeg fall on Saturdays, from 9am to 3pm; and since both Fr Patrick and Fr Nepolian are delegates, this means that **there will be no 5pm Mass at Ste Rose on Dec 2, Jan 20, Feb 24, Mar 17, and Apr 21**. Fr Patrick and Fr Nepolian aim to drive back each Saturday in time for the 7:30 Mass in Laurier.
