October is the Month of the Rosary



October 29th, 30th Sunday of Ordinary Time:

We are One Man. One of the paradoxes of the mystical life is this: that a man cannot enter into the deepest center of himself and pass through that center into God, unless he is able to pass entirely out of himself and empty himself and give himself to other people in the purity of a selfless love.

The more I become identified with God, the more will I be identified with all the others who are identified with Him. His Love will live in all of us. His Spirit will be our One Life, the Life of all of us and Life of God. And we shall love one another and God with the same Love with which He loves us and Himself. This love is God Himself.

Christ prayed that all men might become One as He was One with His Father, in the Unity of the Holy Spirit. Therefore when you and I become what we are really meant to be, we will discover not only that we love one another perfectly but that we are both living in Christ and Christ in us, and we are all One Christ. We will see that it is He Who loves in us.

The ultimate perfection of the contemplative life is not a heaven of separate individuals, each one viewing his own private intuition of God; it is a sea of Love which flows through the One Body of all the elect, all the angels and saints, and their contemplation would be incomplete if it were not shared, or if it were shared with fewer souls, or with spirits capable of less vision and less joy.

I will have more joy in heaven and in the contemplation of God, if you are also there to share it with me; and the more of us there will be to share it the greater will be the joy of all. For contemplation is not ultimately perfect unless it is shared. We do not finally taste the full exultation of God's glory until we share His infinite gift of it by overflowing and transmitting glory all over heaven, and seeing God in all the others who are there, and knowing that He is the Life of all of us and that we are all One in Him.

Even on earth it is the same, but in obscurity. This unity is something we cannot yet realize and enjoy except in the darkness of faith. But even here the more we are one with God the more we are united with one another; and the silence of contemplation is deep, rich and endless society, not only with God but with men. The contemplative is not isolated in himself, but liberated from his external and egotistic self by humility and purity of heart—therefore there is no longer any serious obstacle to simple and humble love of other men.

The more we are alone with God the more we are with one another, in darkness, yet a multitude. And the more we go out in one another in work and activity and communication, according to the will and charity of God, the more we are multiplied in Him and yet we are in solitude.

The more we are alone, the more we are together; and the more we are in society, the true society of charity, not of cities and crowds, the more we are alone with Him...

Dear Parishioners of Ste. Rose, Laurier and McCreary,

1. Regarding Sharing God's Gifts Appeal 2017

This year the Archdiocese has restructured its finances. In this restructuring the targets for the Parish Appeal, which is commonly known as *Sharing God's Gifts*, have been reduced.

Our targets for SGG this year 2017 are as follows: Ste. Rose \$8,420 Laurier \$2,410 McCreary \$1,890

While our *Appeal* (SGG) targets have been reduced, our Parish *Assessments* (the Archdiocesan tax) have been increased to 16% of our Sunday Collections from the previous year. Thus we will be assessed as follows: Ste Rose \$13,220, Laurier \$3,780, McCreary \$2,970

It would be to our advantage to think of these Assessment amounts as belonging also to our *Sharing God's Gifts* targets. Given this, the following would be our targets: **Ste Rose \$21,640 Laurier \$6,190 McCreary \$4,860**

Please note that any funds we collect over our SGG targets will be returned to our parishes untaxed. Thus, for instance, if Ste Rose collected \$22 000, \$13 580 (= 22000 – 8420) would be returned to our parish (and could be used for paying the Assessment).

Please pray about giving of your wealth according to the Stewardship model: 90% your needs 5% your Parish 3% other charities 2% Sharing God's Gifts.

2. Regarding the Ste Rose Roof

The work on the roof is complete. We've not yet received the final report, but we expect to receive it soon. In the meantime, you may have noticed that the church lost some shingles in the last windstorm – and you may have also noticed that that too has been repaired. Our thanks to those involved in those repairs.

3. Regarding the Synod

The Archbishop's Synod is moving into its third phase: all parishes are sending delegates to a number of conventions in Winnipeg, where the delegates will vote on a number of propositions written by the various Synod committees. Please pray that the delegates would be blessed with wisdom and discretion.

These upcoming conventions in Winnipeg fall on Saturdays, from 9am to 3pm; and since both Fr Patrick and Fr Nepolian are delegates, this means that **there will be no 5pm Mass at Ste Rose on Nov 4, Dec 2, Jan 20, Feb 24, Mar 17, and Apr 21.** Fr Patrick and Fr Nepolian aim to drive back each Saturday in time for the 7:30 Mass in Laurier.
