



Job POSTING

Head Lifeguard (HL) and Health Care officer, St-Malo Catholic Camps

At beach:

- Ensure that camp policy, training and practices are conducive to water safety and meet legal and MCA requirements;
- Assess swimming conditions; decide when water activities should be cancelled or cut short;
- Ensure that water safety equipment is brought to the beach and that swimming limits are clearly marked by lane ropes, etc. ;
- Scan the swimming area for hazards (St Malo Provincial Park has a groomed beach);
- Supervise and train assistant lifeguard(s);
- Actively supervise swimmers and oversee supervisors;
- Report to the CC (Camp Coordinator) if counseling or life guarding staff / volunteers are not following SM.C.C water safety and conduct policies and procedures;
- Perform regular "Buddy Checks" while at beach;
- Will always be available for canoe activity sessions, and will be responsible for providing all safety equipment, and to ensure that the activity period is run in a safe and law-abiding way
- Respond to water based emergencies.

Outside of beach time:

- Be at the registration table at the beginning of each week, and speak to each parent regarding their child's(ren's) medical treatment during their week at camps;
- Will be responsible for administering medication to campers and under-aged counselors through the week of camps;
- Will be on-call at any time during week of camps to tend to any medical or health needs or emergencies;
- Will be responsible for maintenance of First Aid cabinet and room;
- Will communicate with CC any significant health issues, and will keep a daily log of any health care issues that arose;
- Will be responsible for accompanying campers who must be admitted at a hospital;
- Will be available to take on any other health care-related responsibilities, or necessary program duties, as delegated by CC.

Minimum qualifications

- As per current lifesaving legislation: valid and up to date NLS certification, Standard First Aid & CPR C, and be least 16 years of age.

Background checks and Conduct Expectations

- The HL is not required to be a practicing catholic. They must, however, be respectful of the SM.C.C's Christian values and atmosphere;
- The HL is expected to abide by the standards of conduct and other policies outlined in the SM.C.C Policy and Procedures Manual;
- The HL will agree to submit a Criminal Record Check and a Child Abuse Registry Check.
